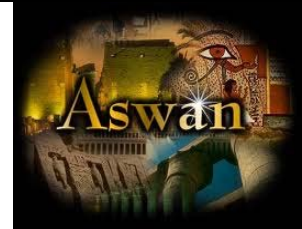

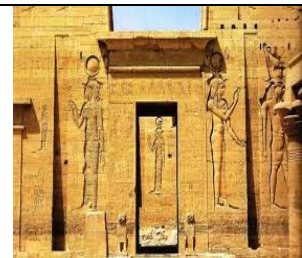

Though you may imagine the sand will stick it does not. Carefully brush with your hand and you will have a marvelous loaf of bread Fried dates is very simple- just a little oil in a pan over the fire.
